COORDINATOR'S MESSAGE

What a year 2022-2023 proved to be! Accès Microcrédit Gaspésie-Îles-de-la-Madeleine (AMCGÎM) has probably had its biggest year since its creation, in many respects. Its success has been such that the organization must now take a moment to reflect on its structure and optimize its ways of doing things in order to fully accomplish its mission, both with customers and the community.

Indeed, the year that just ended saw AMCGÎM support a record number of promoters, not only in terms of loans made, but also in terms of individual coaching. To give you an idea of the scope of the work carried out during this past year, we are talking about 76 new people coached versus 55 the previous year, a total of 21 loans made versus 10 in 2021-2022, and a record loan amount of \$277,500. To give an idea, this sum represents more than 26% of the total loans disbursed since the organization was founded. This was also the year we passed the million-dollar mark in loans. These achievements would certainly not have been possible without the support of the Réseau MicroEntreprendre and its efforts to capitalize on the network's member organizations.

What's more, of all the projects we supported, we were present in every corner of Gaspésie and the Magdalen Islands, in both English and French. In fact, of the 21 loans made, eleven went to women, four to English-speaking entrepreneurs, including one to a Mi'kmaq entrepreneur, and one to the Magdalen Islands

On the other hand, all these hours of coaching have had their impact on the organization. While the financing and coaching of businesspeople has seen considerable growth, the workshops offered by AMCGÎM have slowed down due to a lack of time. Remedying this situation is one of the challenges for the coming year.

2023-2024 is already shaping up well, with the pace showing no signs of slowing down. We're already looking at ways to optimize our operations so that we can fully accomplish our mission and reach all our objectives, with both English-speaking and French-speaking communities throughout the territory we serve. We look forward to seeing our team grow and continue to actively contribute to the improvement of living conditions in the community, and to the economic development of the Magdalen Islands and Gaspésie.

OUR MISSION

Accès Microcrédit Gaspésie-Îles-de-la-Madeleine's mission is to contribute to the **economic and human development** of the community by offering technical support, local coaching and financing services to people with limited access to ordinary financial services, so that they can carry out **job-creating projects** and take their place in the **local and regional economy.**

Funds for women entrepreneurs

Funded by the Government of Canada and in partnership with Evol and Entreprendre Ici, this new program for women entrepreneurs is designed to help women start up or expand their businesses with loans of \$20,000 or less. Through this fund, women can benefit from a one-year complete moratorium on principal and interest payments, and repayment terms of up to 72 months.

ACHIEVEMENTS 2022-2023



Our team is proud to have supported more than 76 entrepreneurs in their entrepreneurial journey.

With an approved loan amount of \$277,500, of which \$265,000 has been disbursed, and approximately \$2.6M in total project costs, the 2022-2023 year was marked by considerable leverage and substantial impact in the community.


Also in 2022-2023, nearly 11 people from English-speaking communities sought our support services.


PORTRAIT OF THE CLIENTELE

CUSTOMER PROFILES SINCE THE COMPANY WAS FOUNDED






<u>AGE</u>

People aged between 26 and 49 account for 70% of our clientele.




More than the majority (56%) of the people we support have a college or university education.


47% of the people we have assisted since the creation of AMCGÎM have a college or university education.


FoodAs Cuisine (MRC Bonaventure)
