The year 2025-2026 was defined by leadership for Accès Microcrédit Gaspésie-Îles-de-la-Madeleine, a clear sign of the organization's strong maturity and enviable stability.

We are proud to have supported over 78 new entrepreneurs from diverse backgrounds and to have continued guiding 42 active clients to ensure the sustainability of their business projects. With \$209,800 in loans granted this year, and an investment fund now exceeding \$1.3 million, AMCGIM strives to be a driver of social and economic development in the Gaspésie and Îles regions by offering financial and technical support to individuals excluded from mainstream entrepreneurship support programs.

At the regional level, AMCGIM played a key unifying role within the economic development sector by taking charge of organizing the first regional gathering of economic development partners. This initiative demonstrates our organization's prominent position in the region and helps cement AMCGIM as an essential player in Gaspésie and the Îles.

Driven by a stable and committed team, these actions reflect years of dedication to ensuring the organization's growth and long-term viability. It is with great satisfaction that we note an enviable stability within our team, featuring employees with several years of experience and a remarkably positive job satisfaction rate.

Finally, the organization continued its collaborative and innovative efforts by developing new, creative initiatives in cooperation with a wide variety of local stakeholders. This was done with a constant focus on better serving our target clientele and fully achieving our mission: to offer empowerment opportunities to individuals excluded from traditional financing paths so they can fulfill their entrepreneurial dreams.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

With several years of strong performance in achieving its objectives and firmly established partnerships, Accès Microcrédit Gaspésie-Îles-de-la-Madeleine (AMCGIM) tackled the 2025-2026 year with confidence and bold determination. It was indeed a year marked by the development of visionary projects for our entrepreneurial clientele, but it also saw the organization take on significant leadership within the regional entrepreneurial development ecosystem.

First and foremost, it is important to highlight the excellent work of our current team, which continues its dedicated efforts in client support. Demand remains very high, and despite being a small team, AMCGIM manages to provide an impressive number of high-quality coaching hours to over 130 different clients, as well as financial support to 19 new business projects across the entire territory.

Building on these convincing results, AMCGIM undertook the development of a new fund during the year. Always striving to offer accessible financing options to individuals who lack access to conventional credit sources, the organization launched the Fonds Desjardins de soutien à l'entrepreneuriat jeunesse (Desjardins Youth Entrepreneurship Support Fund). Supported by the Caisses Desjardins of Gaspésie and the Îles, this fund will now enable young people aged 16 to 20 to benefit from a generous financing program for small-scale, yet highly promising business projects.

Furthermore, embracing its role as a regional economic development organization and working in close collaboration with Innovation Gaspésie, AMCGIM decided to provide leadership among regional partners. Our two organizations organized the first edition of the Gaspésie economic development partners' meetings. This inaugural event was a resounding success, bringing together over 50 stakeholders from across the region to network and brainstorm innovative ways to collaborate on supporting entrepreneurs.

It is therefore with great pride that we see how, in 2025-2026, AMCGIM has truly established itself as a leading player, demonstrating strong leadership and the capacity to successfully carry out major initiatives related to the economic development of Gaspésie and the Îles-de-la-Madeleine. The future is sure to bring its share of challenges, but it looks incredibly promising nonetheless!

YOUTH ENTREPRENEURSHIP FUND

With the invaluable support of the Caisses Desjardins of Gaspésie and the Îles-de-la-Madeleine, and in collaboration with the region's Carrefours jeunesse-emploi (CJE), our organization launched the Fonds Desjardins-AMCGÎM de soutien à l'entrepreneuriat jeunesse (FSEJ—Desjardins-AMCGÎM Youth Entrepreneurship Support Fund) for young entrepreneurs with big business ideas.

The FSEJ aims to provide young people aged 16 to 20 who have serious, viable entrepreneurial projects with the tools they need to bring their ideas to life, covering technical, human, and financial aspects alike.

STRATEGIC RETREAT

In the fall of 2025, the team and board of directors of Accès Microcrédit Gaspésie-Îles-de-la-Madeleine headed to the Camp de base in Coin du Banc. This strategic retreat, facilitated by Benoit Trépanier, provided the perfect opportunity to lay down the final milestones of our strategic plan.

The year 2025-2026 bears witness to Accès Microcrédit's tangible impact on the ground, with nearly 80 entrepreneurs benefiting from our team's support and coaching. The 19 loans granted this year, totaling \$209,800, propelled projects with a global value of \$1,745,179, illustrating an exceptional leverage effect for our community.

Of note is the strong vitality within the retail and service sectors, which alone accounted for 13 of this year's investments.

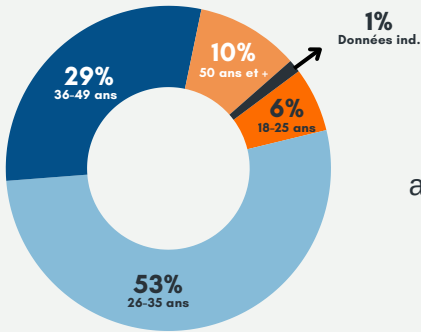
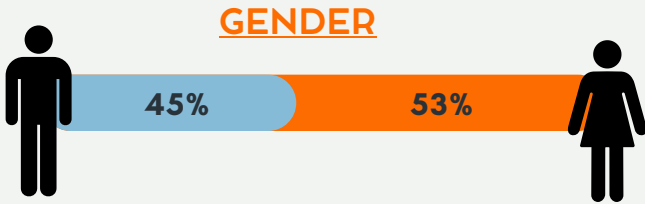

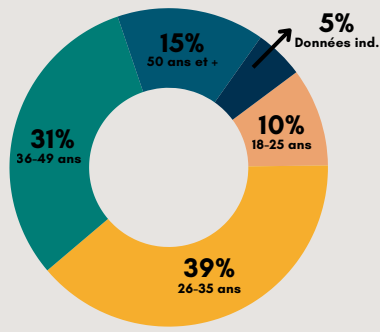
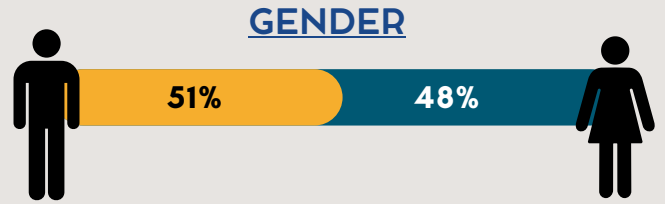
PROFILE OF OUR CLIENTELE

People aged 26 to 49 account for 82% of our 2025-2026 clientele."

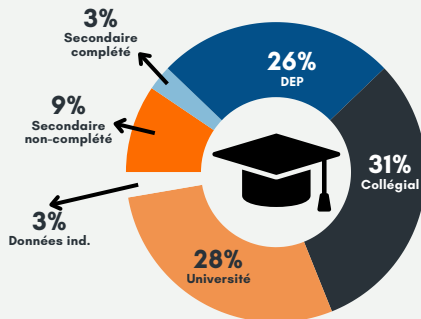
PROFILE OF THE CLIENTELE SINCE THE CREATION



People aged 26 to 49 account for 70% of our client base over the last few years.

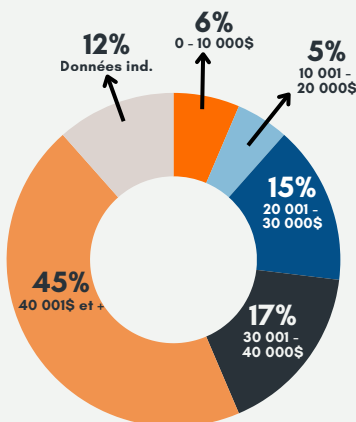
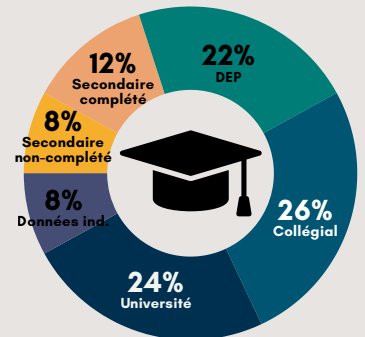

Nearly 40% of the individuals supported have an education level below the college level.



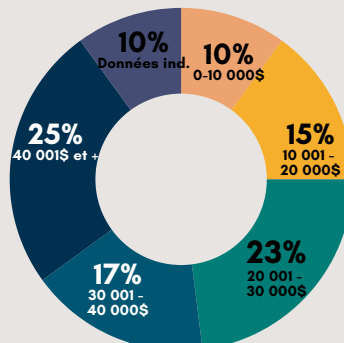
EDUCATION

Over the past few months, AMCGÎM joined forces with Culture Gaspésie to roll out a strategic series of three virtual workshops. 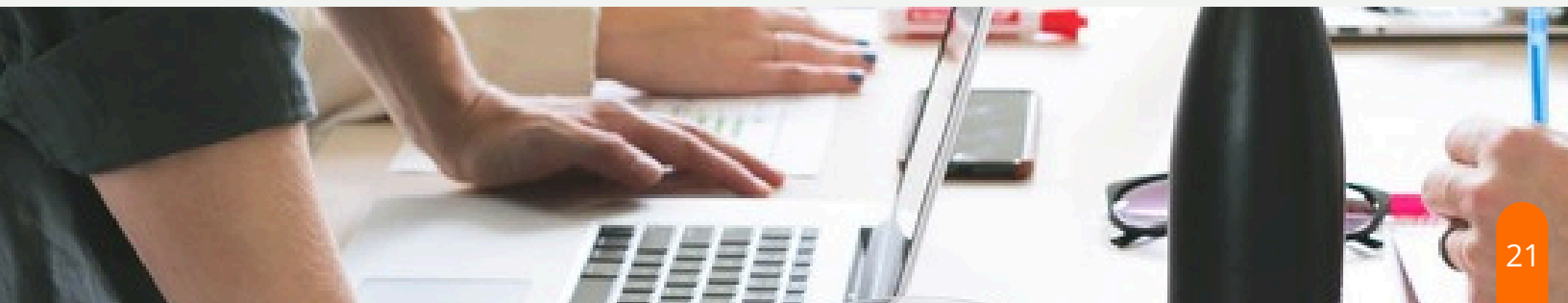
